EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

When Fixed-Fixed deadlocks occur, both partners agree to a 48-hour pause before revisiting the disagreement. This prevents the war-of-attrition dynamic. John uses this time for his Life Path 3 journaling practice. Jane uses it for her Chaldean 7 analytical processing.
